

## Four Oaks Primary School Plan for Distance Learning



Dear Parents,

In the present situation we have no choice but to follow official advice and close our school. This does not mean however that we will not continue to set the children a variety of learning activities. We have listed below the different ways in which the teaching staff will be able to keep in touch with the pupils.

### WORDPRESS



Wordpress is the self-contained part of our school website that we use on an everyday basis to give parents messages about children's learning and set homework tasks.

As such, this is the perfect vehicle to pass on learning tasks during this period of school closure. We ask that all children visit their year group area of Wordpress every day to look at what their teachers would like them to do in terms of learning at home. Daily tasks will be set by 9am every day.

Activities that may be placed on there could be:

- writing tasks
- reading tasks
- mathematical challenges
- one subject from our foundation subject based around our topic

These tasks will be suggested activities, but obviously it is up to you as parents as to whether you have the time, or your child is well enough, to complete these. These activities will obviously not be marked as work is presently in school, but will be rewarded with smiley faces or house points on returning to school.

### MATHLETICS



All of our children have access to Mathletics on-line and already use it frequently in school and at home. Teachers have the ability to set children specific tasks and exercises within Mathletics and they will be able to monitor children's progress in what they do and how successful their learning is. These tasks will be allocated per pupil and will be signposted via Wordpress.

### BUG CLUB



All of our children have access to the Bug Club reading and phonics scheme on-line and already use it frequently in school and at home. Teachers have the ability to set children specific tasks and exercises within Bug Club and they will be able to monitor children's progress in what they tackle. These tasks will be allocated per pupil and will be signposted via Wordpress.
