

Athletics


Well done to our Athletics Team who made the final of the athletics tournament, we hope they had a great time today at King Edward's School.

Grow your Greens!

For this year's Eco Challenge at Streetly Methodist Church

- 1. Choose some seeds- the packet will tell you how long they take to grow and how much soil they
- need.

 2. Find a container- it could be anything from a yoghurt pot to a bucket but it will need drainage holes in the bottom. Ask an adult to help.
- 3. Decorate the out side of your pot then add soil or compost
- 4. Add seeds, stand your pot where it will get some sun and be sure to water it regularly
- 5. Watch your plants grow and harvest them when ready. Some leaves grow quickly and you may be able to plant more seeds and get several crops over the season.



You can grow cress in a yoghurt pot or potatoes in a bucket or carrier bag



Radishes, lettuce, spinach and herbs are easy to grow. Why not try something you haven't eaten before? You can buy packs of 'mixed salad leaves' seeds that are ready to eat in 3-4 weeks. Have fun
