School Dinners & SchoolMoney

As we have now used School Money for all payments in school for one term, I hope that you will agree this system is a lot easier and convenient for everyone and is working well. However, some parents are still not paying weekly, or putting money into their accounts in advance, which is the only way the system can work successfully without running up individual debts.

Reminders are then sent out for each week owed and so some parents are receiving a succession of texts which are not being acted upon. Therefore from January onwards we will now be running a system where any debts will not be allowed to go over £10. If this limit is reached then your child will have to come to school with a packed lunch until the debt is cleared.

I hope that you all appreciate the situation that we find ourselves in and agree that this is a positive move as it is not sustainable for school to keep subsiding these cumulative debts. If you do get text reminders about your account levels then we would really appreciate it if you could act upon them in a timely manner. However if there are problems with settling any accounts then please come into school and talk to either myself or Mrs Johnson. Many thanks for your understanding with this issue.




ICT Tip of the Week

Smart home hubs like Alexa, consider what they can do, can they make purchases, play music tracks with explicit lyrics and does the microphone always need to be on and listening or can it be turned off when not needed? Games consoles, can children communicate with other gamers and join chat rooms? Are games age appropriate? What is in the gameplay? 
