Next Year - PE Days & Start of the Day

We would like to inform parents of two parts of our COVID school structure that we are going to keep for the next academic year.

Firstly, we will keep to the rule that all pupils will come to school dressed in their PE kit on the days that they have PE. This was introduced to reduce physical contact between pupils and staff at the height of COVID, but it has had such a positive impact in terms of time saved, and health and safety levels in corridors without PE bags being present, that we will continue with this rule. We hope that this will also help parents in terms of the amount of school uniform you will need to purchase. We would ask that all children do however come dressed in normal Four Oaks Primary School PE kit, as listed in our school prospectus, and not in their own sporting clothes!

Secondly we will continue with all of our pupils walking into school independently each morning. We will continue with the arrangement that parents will drop their children off at the main school gates, and the children will walk around our one-way system to their classroom exterior door. Each gate (Junior, Infant and Russell Bank Road) will be open for 10 minutes between 8.50am and 9am. Doing this for the last year, our children, particularly our younger pupils, have become so much more independent and it allows for a quick and calm start to the school day. Parents will obviously be allowed on site at the end of the day to collect their children.



ICT Tip of the Week

As children start to explore the internet, they may come across content that isn't suitable for their age, or that may upset them or worry them. If you're worried your child may have been taking, sharing or receiving inappropriate or explicit images, it can help to:

- talk to them about what they're sharing or have seen, and if they know who else has seen the pictures
- remind them that people online may not be who they say they are
- explain that they should always think carefully about what they share online, as once it's been sent, they lose control of it
- suggest they download the **Zipit app** from Childline to help them deal with requests for inappropriate photos
- let them know they can always come to you if they see anything that worries or upsets them online.
