Dear Parents and Governors



I would like to say a huge welcome back to all members of our Four Oaks Family! I hope that you all had an enjoyable Summer break but also had the chance for a good rest. It has been so lovely to see the children back in school since Wednesday... school should not be a quiet place and it has been a bubbly and lively place every day so far.

Now that we are able, we have reintroduced all aspects of school life that were in place pre-Covid and you will see planned events on either the 'Diary Dates' page of our school website, or on the list of dates at the end of this newsletter.

So, here are some details of events that involve you all as parents.

Parent Workshops

You will see that in the first three full weeks of school all year groups will be holding a 'Parents' Workshop'. It is really important that if possible every child has a parent or adult who can come to these events. They will start at 9am and finish by 10.30am at the latest. In these workshops the teachers will go through the structure of the work in their year group and will talk about some really important aspects of the children's work. You will then get a chance to actually work alongside your child, but please do not worry.....there will be no tests involved! The Reception workshop in September however is just for parents.

Year Group Assemblies

Over the course of the school year you will see that there is a date for each year group to perform an assembly for their parents. This performance will reflect the children's efforts in their curriculum work and will give all parents a chance to celebrate their children's successes. At the end of these assemblies the parents of that year group will be invited to stay for lunch and eat with their children. This lunch can be paid for using School Money in the week previous to the assembly. These assemblies will begin at 10am and lunch will then be served at 11am before the other children in school break for lunch. We hope that all parents will appreciate and enjoy the chance to share their children's learning again.

New Reception Children

Next week we will be excited to welcome our new Reception children into school. We will have the youngest 20 children on Monday, the middle 20 children on Tuesday and the oldest 20 children on Wednesday. This means that by Wednesday lunchtime our Four Oaks Family will once more be complete! Reception families bringing their children into school must use the front Infant entrance on Edge Hill Road next week so we can check off names and welcome them in person. Each group of 20 will need to come into the Reception playground at 9.30am.
